Dr. Windhorst appeared via Zoom and presented "The Infrared Universe Beyond Hubble: The James Webb Space Telescope in 2022 and 2023." Dr. Windhorst's discussion was broken into two parts:

- Part 1: How the telescope was designed, built, tested, and deployed
- Part 2: An overview of JWST images to date.

This was a very thorough and informative follow-up to his March presentation on the JWST mission and included two Question and Answer sessions.
