<u>Featured Speaker</u>: Our speaker this month was Sam Myers, a Ph.D. candidate at the Lunar and Planetary Laboratory at the University of Arizona, discussing "From Dinos to Dart: Protecting the Earth from Asteroids."

Sam discussed planetary defense and science policy. His presentation covered asteroid basics, comparative risks of impacts, asteroid sizes, and planetary defense components (detecting asteroids, characterizing the danger, prevention strategies, and how to recover from an asteroid strike).
