<u>Featured Speaker</u>: Our speaker this month was Professor David Williams from the School of Earth and Space Exploration at Arizona State University discussing NASA's Psyche asteroid mission: "Psyche – Exploration of a Metal World."

Dr. Williams discussed why we choose to explore space, NASA mission directorates (aeronautics, space technology, space operations, exploration systems development and science), how we explore the solar system, the status of solar system exploration, and the Psyche asteroid mission. He detailed the Psyche mission's driving question and key parameters.
